Exclusions

The patient can be referred into the service provided they do not fall within one of the following excluded categories:

- · Patients not registered with Wakefield GP
- Patients requiring Urgent/ A&E care including trauma
- Suspected Cancers / two-week waits
- Diabetic Retinal Screening
- Wet AMD
- Children under the age of 18

Providing a quality service


